

Job Description: Literacy Coach

Ashley River Classical Academy (ARCA) is hiring its founding staff members to provide support to its teachers, students, and families when it opens in Charleston, SC in August 2025. ARCA is a tuition-free, public, classical charter school. It is part of the <u>Barney Charter School Initiative</u> of Hillsdale College, a network of classical charter schools united by curriculum and purpose. Ashley River Classical Academy will initially open K-5 and grow to K-12 by adding one grade level each year. Ashley River Classical Academy is now accepting applications for the Dean of Students.

Each faculty member is a professional who is esteemed and supported by a faculty of colleagues striving for excellence. - Researching and recommending instructional materials and best practices in literacy instruction
- Demonstrating and modeling excellent literacy instruction at all grade levels
- Assisting with the inventory of literacy materials and coordinating necessary purchases
- Planning and delivering high-quality professional development opportunities for faculty
- Consistently demonstrating the school's Virtues: Prudence, Justice, Temperance, Courage, Responsibility, Compassion, and Perseverance

- Familiarity with best practices in literacy instruction
- Significant teaching experience; experience with classical education is preferred
